

City of Bel Aire Utility Advisory Committee Minutes  
Monday June 17, 2019

1. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Chairman Tenbrink at 12:02 PM.
2. Roll Call: present – Moss, Broyles, Watkins, Wynn and Tenbrink. Also in attendance were Public Works Director and City Engineer Anne Stephens.
3. Approval of Agenda: Moss moved to approve the agenda, seconded by Wynn, agenda approved.
4. Approval of May 20, 2019 Meeting minutes, moved by Watkins and seconded by Moss, minutes were approved.
5. New Business:
  - A. Debriefing of Waste Connections Recycling Center tour: the committee had a lengthy discussion on the committee's tour of the recycle center. It was noted the facilities cleanliness had degraded since the last time the committee toured the facility, but due to the dirtiness of the job it would be difficult to keep clean. Also the employees still were not wearing dust mask or hearing protection. All in all it still an impressive operation how they separate the single stream recyclables into different recycle marketable product.
  - B. Promoting "Did You Know" Tenbrink said he was asked by the city staff if we would do a DYK on what items were recyclable. He responded by telling them we had already done that. It was discussed if the DYK was posted on the city social media outlets and where all you can find this information. Tenbrink said he would invite Tristin Terhune to the next meeting.
  - C. Composition of the next DYK: The reviewed the next DYK subject Curb Side Cleanup. After a review it was decided to make a minor wording change and the DYK was approved by the committee.

  - A Moss talked about the good job the city did cleaning up around of the bridge at Eagle Lake, also the signs around Eagle lake still had not been put back in place.
  - B. Broyles talk about how expensive it was to replace his out side water hydrant on the back side of his house. .
  - C. Wynn has been following the wind farm hearings and is disappointed on the band placed on renewable energy in Sedgwick County.
  - D. Watkins Told about demo of a house in the Riverside area and the difficult he had trying to get the new electrical wiring and service inspected.

E. Stephens handed out the latest water usage charts for the committees review. Also the construction on Woodlawn would start August 2020.

F Tenbrink mention that Waste Connections had asked for a rate increase, but the city governing body had turn it down. Ted Henry and Anne have asked the committee for help in looking at a rate increase to cover CUA sewer update that in the planning stage.
