

City of Bel Aire Utility Advisory Committee Minutes  
Monday September 16, 2019

1. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Chairman Tenbrink at 12:04 PM.
2. Roll Call: present – Broyles, Wynn and Tenbrink. Moss and Watkins were absent.
3. Approval of Agenda: Broyles moved to approve the agenda, seconded by Wynn, agenda approved.
4. Approval of July 8, 2019 Meeting minutes, moved by Wynn and seconded by Broyles, minutes were approved.
5. New Business:
  - A. The committee approved October's "Did You Know" article on reusable waste recyclables and November's article on household water consumption winter average.
  - B. Chairman Tenbrink reminded the committee in November the UAC will have an election for the committee's officers.
  - C. Chairman Tenbrink handed out an UAC membership roster for the committee members to have.
6. Round table discussion:
  - A. Broyles Stated he had made a road trip last week to visit his terminally ill sister in Arizona and that she had passed away last Saturday after he had returned home.
  - B. Wynn said she would like to see a program to help aid the elderly who live alone at home. They could call when they had a simple task to do that they where not able to do for themselves.
  - C. Tenbrink stated the City had approved the cost of a design concept a new sewer lift station to sever the northeast area west of Webb Road and south of K-254. Teflon membrane coating PFA that has high temperature resistance and used by fire fighters is now having some health concerns. EPA is repelling some of the water run off restrictions. Coal usage is down 30% is has caused 2 coal companies to shut down. Several plumbing contractors believe that they are licensed in Bel Aire to inspect lawn sprinklers back flow preventers because they are licensed in Wichita or other surrounding cities.
