We are pleased to introduce the City of Bel Aire's newly designed utility bill. This update marks the first step toward our future utility billing system, designed to serve you more efficiently and provide greater access to essential information about your account. Key features of the new system will include:

- A self-service portal with 24/7 online access to bills and account details
- Convenient online payment options
- Paperless billing options
- The ability to view usage history and trends

WHAT HAS CHANGED?

Currently, the only changes are the design of the bill and your new account number. A sample bill with account number section highlighted is provided on the reverse side of this page. You will continue to use the existing portal for payments. If you have set up automatic bank drafts, these will proceed as scheduled on December 5th.

WHEN WILL THE NEW PAYMENT PORTAL BE AVAILABLE?

Our team is working closely with our vendor to finalize details and set a launch date. We will share updates soon, so please follow the City of Bel Aire on social media for the latest information.

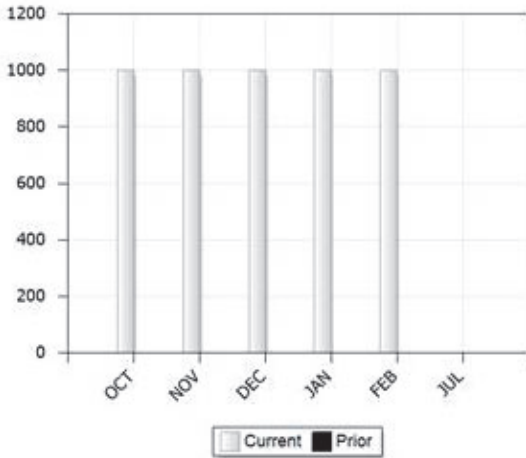

REMINDER: STORM WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION

Please do not blow fallen leaves or grass into storm drains or ditches. Dumping into the stormwater system affects streams and the increase in nutrients associated with grass clippings can cause algae growth.

Ways to use fallen leaves to protect our water and keep this waste out of storm drains:

- Return leaves to the lawn — Mow leaves into your lawn to create mulch. The decomposing leaves provide nutrients that can help your grass grow.
- Use as garden mulch — Leaves can be used as a free mulch for your garden. Small leaves can be raked directly onto planting beds, while larger leaves should be chopped first. When using leaves as mulch, arrange them around the stems of plants and shrubs, leaving some space for airflow.
- Compost — Shredded leaves can be added to a compost pile along with other materials like grass and twigs. The resulting compost can be used in gardens and flower beds in the spring.



KEEP OUR WATER CLEAN: SCOOP THE POOP!

Pet waste is NOT fertilizer. If left on the ground, harmful bacteria and parasites can wash into our waterways. This runoff can make water unsafe for both people and wildlife.
