

SPRING IS HERE – PLEASE KEEP WATER CONSERVATION IN MIND!

March 20 marks the first day of spring, and it's time to start thinking about your lawn and garden. As you begin planning, please remember that our community remains in a Stage Two Drought Response. The following water restrictions are still in effect:

- A four-zone watering system is in place for all residents. Outdoor lawn and landscape irrigation is limited to once per week between 8 p.m. and 10 a.m.
(See the map of Bel Aire's Four Zone Watering System)
- Irrigation systems using well water or naturally fed ponds are exempt but are encouraged to voluntarily reduce usage, as all water sources are interconnected and affected by drought conditions.
- If using well water or pond water for irrigation, a visible sign must be placed at the site.
- Outdoor water use, including lawn watering and car washing, is only allowed between 8 p.m. and 10 a.m.
- Wasting water, as defined by the Water Drought Emergency Ordinance, is prohibited.

Let's work together to conserve this vital resource!

KECHI BRUSH SITE

Did you know that all Bel Aire residents have access to the Kechi Brush Site, thanks to a cooperative agreement between the two cities? Located at the south end of Anderson Avenue and Losh Lane, simply bring proof of address, such as a driver's license or utility bill, to access the site.

Hours: Second Saturday of each month | 8 a.m. – 12 p.m.

What's allowed: Branches, brush, limbs

What's not allowed: Tree trunks, grass, leaves, trash

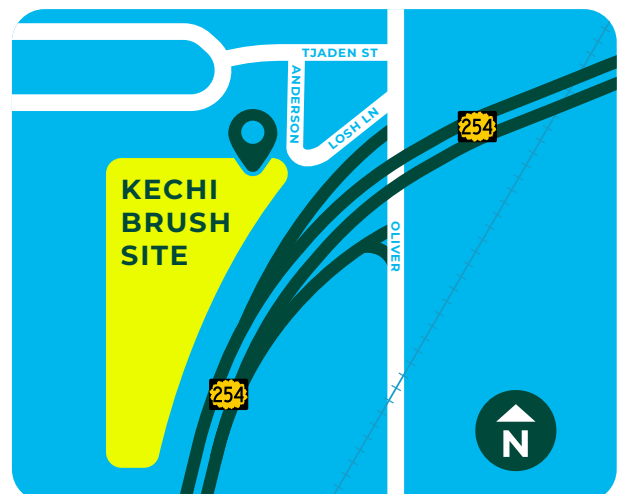


WATERING SCHEDULE BY ZONE

- #1:** Mondays: 8 p.m. until 10 a.m. Tues.
- #2:** Tuesdays: 8 p.m. until 10 a.m. Wed.
- #3:** Wednesdays: 8 p.m. until 10 a.m. Thurs.
- #4:** Thursdays: 8 p.m. until 10 a.m. Fri.

No watering is allowed between the hottest hours of the day (10 AM until 8 PM).

No irrigation allowed Saturday or Sunday.



WATER CONSERVATION REBATE PROGRAM

All Bel Aire utility customers are eligible to receive up to \$500 in rebates through the City of Wichita Water Conservation Rebate Program. The program aims to help cover the costs of purchasing approved water conservation devices or upgrading inefficient appliances and fixtures between now and December 31, 2025.

Funds are distributed on a first-come, first-served basis until depleted and rebates will be credited directly to the customer's utility account. A total rebate allowance of \$30,000 will be distributed among Wichita's wholesale water customers, which includes Bel Aire.
