

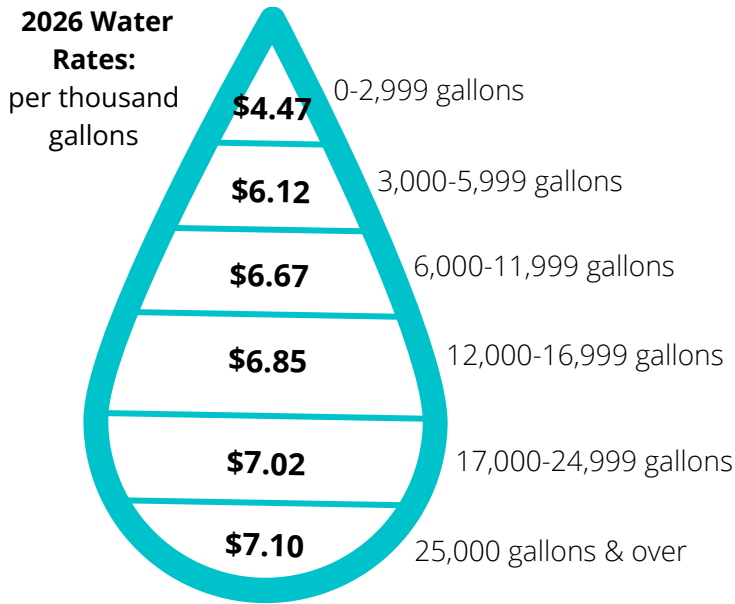
# Utility Bills Explained:

## Where does your money go?

### WA Water

Water is billed for the total amount of gallons that pass through your individual meter plus the base rate.

**BASE RATE = \$36.29**  
(regardless of water usage)



Rates are established by a Resolution as adopted by the City Council. Per the current Resolution, the water and sewer rates are scheduled to increase by 3% annually beginning January 1, 2017.

### SF Stormwater Management Fee

Effective August 2016, a Stormwater Management Fee was added to the utility bills. The fee goes towards maintaining and replacing stormwater items such as culverts, curbs, and storm drains.

### SW Sewer

Sewer rates are calculated every year based on your average winter water usage, known as Winter Average Consumption (WAC). Water usage is tracked from November through February, and the three months with the lowest usage during this period are averaged to establish the new rate. This WAC will be used from April to March of the following year when WAC is recalculated.

Any water leak repairs made during this time should be reported to the Utility Department.



**WAC IS AN AVERAGE OF YOUR THREE LOWEST WATER USAGE MONTHS BETWEEN NOVEMBER AND FEBRUARY.**

To determine your account's monthly sewer rate, the WAC will be multiplied by the current sewer rate, plus the base rate.



**BASE RATE = \$41.65**  
+\$7.54 per thousand gallons

### PF Protection Fee

This fee is set by Environmental Protection Agency and collected monthly by the City to ensure that you are delivered clean, safe, consumable water.



## TR Trash (Optional)

You are free to choose a trash company of your choice or use the City's contracted hauler.

Bel Aire contracts with Waste Connections for weekly trash service and recycle service every other week.

You are allowed up to 3 extra bags of trash or bundled limbs with your 95-gallon cart. Trash must be at curb by 6 AM.

## RC Recycling **Flat-Rate \$4.61**

The recycling fee is not optional. All residents are charged a recycling fee per Ordinance 385 adopted by the City Council in 2002.

Recycle bins are 95-gallon carts that enable you to throw all recyclable products into one bin without sorting. Recycle bins are serviced every other week on your designated trash day. *All items MUST fit in the cart; excess will not be picked up.*

## Utility Highlights

Utility bills are processed near the 15th of each month and due by 5:30 p.m. on the 10th of the following month to avoid a late penalty.

Should the 10th fall on a weekend or city observed holiday, payment will be due by 8:00 a.m. the next business day. Late payments are subject to a 5% late fee.

## City of Bel Aire-Waste Connections Trash Service



Bel Aire currently offers the following trash and recycling services.

### 95-Gallon Trash cart with weekly pick-up service.

*Driver will take up to three (3) additional bags sitting next to 95-gallon trash cart at no extra cost. For additional bags that exceeds the above, call Waste Connections Customer Service at 316-838-4920 for pricing and to schedule pick-up.*

### 95-Gallon Recycle cart with pick up every-other week

*Residents may opt out of participating but will be charged the mandatory fee. All recyclables MUST fit into the container.*

Extra carts may be ordered through the city at an additional monthly cost.

## **TRASH CARTS AND YOU**

- Set out carts by 6 a.m. on your service day
- Place cart within 2 feet of curb and cannot be placed near cars, mailboxes, carts, or other obstructions.
- Place recycle cart 2 feet from curb and 3 feet from trash cart.
- Tree limbs must be in three-foot bundles and count towards the max of three extra bags for the 95 gallon trash cart.
- Fill cart completely before placing bags to the side of trash cart.
- Do not use straps or tie downs on cart lids.

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

- For residents to start or change trash services, contact City of Bel Aire 744-2451 ext. 132.
- To look-up your trash and recycle pick up day, print a trash calendar, or to sign up for alerts; visit <https://www.wasteconnections.com/pickup-schedule/>
- Rollout Service for disabled is available at no additional cost. Cart(s) must be at the front corner of the house and visible from the street. Residents must show City Hall proof of disability card.
- Waste Connections will not operate on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. Pickup day will be altered accordingly.

## **SPECIAL PICK-UPS**

- All special pickups must be scheduled at least three (3) days in advance of pickup. Call 316-838-4920 during the hours of 8am to 5pm to schedule a pickup.
- Any large items left next to the cart and not scheduled in advance for pickup will be left until special arrangements are made.
- Hazardous materials WILL NOT, under any circumstances, be picked up by the trash hauler. You may call Hazardous Waste 660-7464 for drop off locations.

Waste Connections has the free **WasteConnect App**, which enables you to search your address and see your collection schedule for trash & recycle. It can also send you regular service day and Holiday reminders. You can also access the Waste Wizard that will tell you which items are accepted in either the trash or recycle cart. 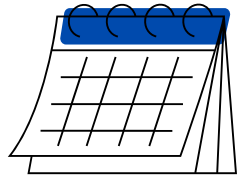

You may be issued a "Uniform Complaint and Notice to Appear" if you:

- ❖ Fail to obtain or possess a dog license.
- ❖ Fail to renew or possess a dog license.
- ❖ Fail to obtain or possess a dangerous dog license.
- ❖ Fail to show a dog license.
- ❖ Obtain a dangerous dog license from a veterinarian.
- ❖ Make a false statement on a license form.
- ❖ Give a worthless check in payment for any dog license.
- ❖ Fail to obtain a dog/cat/ferret rabies vaccination or Veterinarian's Confirmation.
- ❖ Fail to show a dog/cat/ferret rabies vaccination or Veterinarian's Confirmation.
- ❖ Fail to have a metallic vaccination tag on a dog collar unless exempt.
- ❖ Fail to have a collar on your dog.
- ❖ Fail to keep any of your animals on your property or in your control.
- ❖ Interfere with an Animal Control Officer performing that officer's lawful duties.

If you live in the unincorporated areas of Sedgwick County or in a incorporated city contracted with Sedgwick County, this information is important to you as a responsible pet owner.

Your peace of mind, the health and safety of your pet, and your enjoyment of your pet depend on your compliance with the animal codes of Sedgwick County.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED questions:

**?** Do Sedgwick County animal codes apply to me?

**A** Yes, if you live in any unincorporated area of Sedgwick County.  
No, if you live within the corporate boundaries of the City of Wichita.

If you live within the corporate boundaries of any other city in Sedgwick County, you can contact your city clerk or our office to ask if your city has an agreement with Sedgwick County for animal control within your city.



**?** What does Sedgwick County require me to do about vaccinating my dog, cat or ferret?

**A** **For dogs:** The first inoculation of a dog over five (5) months old shall be for a period of one (1) year (twelve (12) months). Prior to the expiration of the first inoculation, the harboree/owner shall have the option of renewing the vaccination for a period of one (1) year (twelve (12) months) or three (3) years (thirty-six (36) months). The harboree/owner shall obtain a veterinarian's written certification annually or for the three-year period, that the dog has been properly vaccinated and a new vaccination tag shall be assigned to each dog.

**A** **For Cats:** The first inoculation of a cat over five (5) months old shall be for a period of one (1) year (twelve (12) months). Each subsequent inoculation shall be obtained annually. The harboree/owner shall obtain a veterinarian's written certification annually that the cat has been properly vaccinated.

**A** **For Ferrets:** The first inoculation of a ferret over five (5) months old shall be for a period of one (1) year (twelve (12) months). Each subsequent inoculation shall be obtained annually. The harboree/owner shall obtain a veterinarian's written certification annually that the ferret has been properly vaccinated.

Your veterinarian will perform this service for you. You will be charged a fee for the vaccination. Your veterinarian will provide you with a copy of the animal's vaccination certificate, which you must keep.

If, **in your veterinarian's professional opinion**, your animal cannot or should not be vaccinated against rabies, you are required to obtain documentation called a "Veterinarian's Confirmation" from your vet which you must keep and provide Sedgwick County Animal Control with a copy.



**?** What does Sedgwick County require me to do about licensing my pet?

**A** All dogs are required to be licensed in Sedgwick County. Cats and ferrets are excused from licensing requirement.

As a convenience to you, your veterinarian can sell you your Sedgwick County dog License at the same time that you have your dog vaccinated for rabies.

The dog license form has been supplied to most veterinarians in Sedgwick County.



**?** Is there any other location where I can purchase my dog license?

**A** Yes, you may purchase it from the Sedgwick County Animal Control office, located at 1015 W. Stillwell, Wichita, KS 67213 or on our website at [www.scanimalcontrol.org](http://www.scanimalcontrol.org).

You must provide a copy of the current rabies vaccination certificate or Veterinarian's Confirmation.

**Sedgwick County Animal Control can not sell you a license without one of these documents.**



**Remember:** The license is only valid for one to three years from the date of either of those forms, and the license will expire with the expiration of the rabies vaccination, the license is not pro-rated.



Once I have my dog/cat/ferret vaccinated and my dog licensed, what am I required to show to a Sedgwick County Animal Control Officer, Code Enforcement Officer, or Law Enforcement Officer?

You **must** show your Sedgwick County Dog License that is current, which shows on its face the proof of rabies vaccination, or has attached to it the "Veterinarian's Confirmation".

You **must** show that your dog is collared with the metallic rabies vaccination tag attached.



For your cat/ferret: \_\_\_\_\_

You **must** show proof of rabies vaccination or a Veterinarian's Confirmation that is current. (Your veterinarian will provide you with one of these documents when you bring your animal in for vaccination.)



If you own a dog that has been previously deemed dangerous you are required follow the steps listed below to license your dog.

You are **prohibited** from purchasing a license for a dangerous dog from your veterinarian.

You **must** obtain such license directly from the Sedgwick County Animal Control office, in person.

You **must** provide a current rabies vaccination certificate or Veterinarian's Confirmation.

You **must** provide proof of homeowner's, renter's or other insurance acknowledging the ownership of such animal previously determined, declared or adjudged to be dangerous or vicious and demonstrating that such animal's subsequent acts are insured by such policy and with such policy listing the Sedgwick County Animal Control Department as an entity to be notified ten (10) days in advance if the policy is cancelled for any reason; or.....

A surety bond in the amount of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) written to cover any acts of such animal previously determined, declared or adjudged to be dangerous or vicious, which bond shall list the Sedgwick County Animal Control Department as an entity to be notified ten (10) days in advance if the surety bond is cancelled for any reason.
