

WATER CONSERVATION REBATE PROGRAM

All Bel Aire utility customers are eligible to receive up to \$500 in rebates through the City of Wichita Water Conservation Rebate Program. The program aims to help cover the costs of purchasing approved water conservation devices or upgrading inefficient appliances and fixtures between now and December 31, 2025.

Funds are distributed on a first-come, first-served basis until depleted and rebates will be credited directly to the customer's utility account. Approximately \$24,000 remains in the allowance fund for Wichita's wholesale water customers, which includes Bel Aire.

WATER USAGE AND ALERTS NOW AVAILABLE

A new feature in the utility billing portal is now available, giving you the ability to track your water usage and set custom alerts. You can receive notifications for potential leaks, when your usage reaches a certain amount, or even if water is running at your property while you're on vacation. To access this feature, log into the utility portal at belaireks.municipalonlinepayments.com or scan the QR code. Once logged in, click on "Consumption" in the menu, then select "Manage Alerts." STAGE TWO RESTRICTIONS STILL IN EFFECT

As a reminder, our community remains in Stage Two of the Drought Response, as outlined in the Municipal Water Conservation Plan. While in Stage Two, outdoor watering is limited to once per week between 8 p.m. and 10 a.m., and all residents must follow the City's Four-Zone Watering System. No irrigation is allowed during the hottest hours of the day or on weekends. This includes all outdoor water use, such as washing vehicles. To determine your zone and watering day, visit belaireks.gov/water.

Properties using well water or naturally fed ponds are exempt from these restrictions, but are strongly encouraged to reduce usage, as all water sources are interconnected. A visible sign is required at any property irrigated with these systems.

SPRING CURBSIDE CLEAN-UP

The 2025 Spring Curbside clean-up will be on **Saturday, May 17**. Waste Connections will make one pass through the city, so please have all items organized and set at the curb (not in trash or recycling carts) before 6 a.m. Please carefully review the list of allowed items below. Any items not in compliance will be left at your curb.

ALLOWED

- ✓ General trash (not in trash or recycle carts - must be in throwaway containers such as boxes or bags, no more than 30-gallon capacity)
- ✓ Small amounts of brush or limbs (cut into 3-foot lengths and bundled)
- ✓ Dried & empty paint cans (lids must be off)
- ✓ Refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioners (must have freon removed and be tagged by a technician stating that freon has been removed)
- ✓ Small electrical appliances
- ✓ Furniture that can be handled safely by one person, such as chairs and tables
- ✓ Patio grills
- ✓ Mattresses
- ✓ Lawn trimmers and push lawnmowers (free of gas and oil)

NOT ALLOWED

- ✗ Loose trash or debris
- ✗ Boxes or bags exceeding 40lbs in weight
- ✗ Construction materials
- ✗ Tires
- ✗ Car batteries
- ✗ Oil filters
- ✗ Propane tanks
- ✗ Fluorescent light bulbs
- ✗ Any asbestos material
- ✗ Explosives
- ✗ Wet paint
- ✗ Hazardous liquids (such as fertilizers, pesticides, herbicides, solvents, diesel fuel, gas, oil, transmission fluid, and antifreeze)
- ✗ Items that can't be handled safely
