

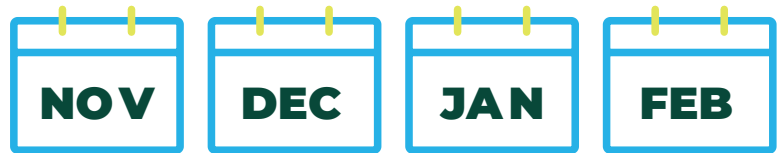
WINTER AVERAGE CONSUMPTION

For all residential and commercial utility customers, sewer rates are based on a Winter Average Consumption (WAC). This year, WAC will track water usage from November through February, and the three months with the lowest usage during this period will be averaged to determine your new WAC.

For example, if your water use is higher in December due to holiday guests, your WAC will be calculated by averaging the usage from November, January, and February instead.

New WAC averages appear on the April bill each year and are applied from April through March of the following year, until the next recalculation.

If you experience a water leak between November and February, be sure to report it to the Utility Department as soon as possible because it may impact your WAC. Residents have until June 1 to dispute their new WAC.

REMINDER: NEW WATERING SCHEDULE IN EFFECT

The City of Bel Aire has transitioned from Stage 2 drought restrictions to a permanent three-day-per-week watering schedule for outdoor irrigation systems. **To determine your weekly watering days, simply check the last digit of your home address:**

- If your address ends in an odd number (1,3,5,7,9), you can water on Wednesdays, Fridays, and Sundays.
- If your address ends in an even number (0,2,4,6,8), you can water on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays.
- No watering on Mondays.

To reduce water loss to evaporation and make the most of every drop, watering is not permitted between 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Please restrict irrigation to the hours of 12:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., and from 6:00 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. on your designated watering days. If drought conditions reemerge in the future, additional measures will take effect, as outlined in the Municipal Water Conservation Plan (belaireks.gov/MWCP).

STORM WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION

KEEP LEAVES OUT OF STORM DRAINAGE: PUT THEM TO GOOD USE

Please don't blow leaves or grass into storm drains or ditches, as this can contribute to algae growth in our stormwater system from excess nutrients. Instead, put those fallen leaves to good use. Mow them into your lawn to create nutrient-rich mulch, use them as free garden mulch around plants and shrubs, or add shredded leaves to your compost pile for use in the spring.



PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PETS

Did you know that pet waste is not fertilizer? When left on the ground, harmful bacteria and parasites can wash into our stormwater system, making it unsafe for people and wildlife. Cleaning up after your pet is not just a matter of courtesy; it is an essential step to protect our community's health and keep Bel Aire clean.
