

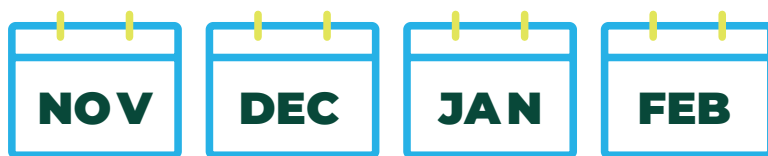
WINTER AVERAGE CONSUMPTION

For all residential and commercial utility customers, sewer rates are based on a Winter Average Consumption (WAC). This year, WAC will track water usage from November through February, and the three months with the lowest usage during this period will be averaged to determine your new WAC.

For example, if your water use is higher in December due to holiday guests, your WAC will be calculated by averaging the usage from November, January, and February instead.

New WAC averages appear on the April bill each year and are applied from April through March of the following year, until the next recalculation.

If you experience a water leak between November and February, be sure to report it to the Utility Department as soon as possible because it may impact your WAC. Residents have until June 1 to dispute their new WAC.

WASTE CONNECTIONS HOLIDAY SCHEDULE & HELPFUL TRASH TIPS

As the holidays approach, please note that Waste Connections observes Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day. If your regularly scheduled pickup day falls on one of these holidays, service will be delayed until the following. To help you never forget a pickup, visit wasteconnections.com to download their convenient app, which provides pickup reminders and essential notifications.

Before placing at the curb, please ensure that all household trash is securely bagged and your cart is not overfilled, allowing the lid to close completely. Waste Connections allows up to three extra bags outside your 95-gallon cart each week, but please ensure they are securely tied to prevent loose materials from blowing away.

Recyclables should be placed loosely in your recycling cart, not in bags. This crucial step helps with efficient sorting at the local Waste Connections facility. Any items left outside of the recycling cart will be collected with regular trash.

GIVE YOUR PIPES A HOLIDAY BREAK

As you prepare your favorite holiday dishes, please remember that grease should never go down the drain. While it may be liquid when hot, it hardens as it cools and causes clogs in household pipes as well as the public sewer lines. Instead, simply pour any grease into a disposable container, let it cool and solidify, and then place it in the trash.

Even small amounts of grease can build up over time, leading to backups and costly repairs. Taking a few extra seconds to dispose of grease properly helps keep everything flowing smoothly all season long.
